
Public Meeting Notice

Saint Vrain Wildfire/ Watershed Assessment



A group of water providers and other stakeholders are working on a wildfire/ watershed assessment and prioritization for the Saint Vrain Watershed. The assessment follows a procedure prescribed by the Front Range Watershed Protection Data Refinement Work Group and will be completed to identify, prioritize, and recommend measures to protect those watersheds that provide or convey critical community water supplies from the adverse effects of post-wildfire hydrologic changes, including flooding, erosion, and deposition. The Watershed Assessment area includes Boulder, Coal, and Left Hand Creeks.
